While teaching forcible entry classes I learned that I wasn't happy with the products on the market. I wanted to design a door that felt like you were forcing an actual door.



The FEDs door is 6'-8" x 36". The door can be broken down into 3 pieces (base, jambs, and the door) for storage and transport. Our door weighs approximately 500lbs.

The door comes standard in black paint and can be custom single color painted to your department's color



Original Lock Idea (Patent Pending)



PVC locks gives the feel of a real deadbolt. It also allows the user to practice multiple techniques.

Life Like forcing

The door can be forced either inward or outward. Hand pump hydraulic door tools may be used to open the prop and also test the functionality of the tool.



On Site Training
